- The words that are spoken have to go within the inverted commas.
- Any punctuation also needs to go within the inverted commas.
- The reporting clause (who and how it is said) can go at the beginning, middle or end.
- A comma follows the reporting clause at the beginning.
- New line when a new character speaks.
